Business Arising from Minutes: Adam repaired the chlorinator. Adam contacted Marven about the chlorinator if it would be feasible to purchase a new chlorinator or repair the old one. Marven suggested purchasing a new one. Coun McIntosh discussed getting rid of the shrubs next to the office building. Adam will price the cost of a wooden fence and a get a quote from Eastern Fencing on a metal fence. The village signs entering and exiting the village needs replaced. Adam will get a quote from Mr. Peterson. There are concerns about the lookout . There needs to be a railing installed. Mr. Pearson has been looking after the project for the village. Adam spoke with Mr. Pearson and he is looking at several options of railing just trying to find a suitable type and within the price range. Council discussed installing a crosswalk and lights by the lookout. Adam will contact DTI to find out what the process is. Enter at your own risk signs should be placed near the lookout to prevent injury. There are several issues going on at the Bath Lions Park, vandalism and children hanging out there and leaving drug paraphernalia behind. There has also been vandalism at the school.
