Public Safety: Things seems to have quieted down in the village, not as many four wheelers around. The trail enforcement have not been around this summer.

Transportation: Mr. Landry is requesting a cost of living increase in the winter maintenance contract this year. The New Brunswick CPI is at zero. Mayor Stone will review. There is an issue with new group home parking along the side of the road entering the fairgrounds. This issue will have to be addressed in the future. Coun McNair suggested maybe paving a section of the roadway, will contact DTI to see if they are interested in providing the asphalt.

Service Clubs: The Terry Fox Run was a huge success. The Bath Lions Club raised over \$4000 for this great cause.

New Business: Coun McNair had a large pine log delivered to the fairgrounds, hoping to have a carving done with the log.
