# **Department and Committee Reports:**

<u>Legal, Finance and Administration:</u> Clerk to send Mayor Stone July financials. Clerk received a complaint from a resident that a truck is keeping them awake at night. Councillor McNair will speak with both parties to try and resolve the issue. There have been no meetings for the Regional Service Commission.

Economic Development: The hospital deal is still going forward. A new power entrance was installed on the clinic and dental office separate from the old hospital. Plans for the balloon festival and woodsmen competition is moving along. Received several sponsorships from local businesses. The Balloon fest will run from Sept 1-5. Mayor Stone and Counc McNair attended the Mayor and council meeting in Hartland to discuss a rural community or a regional municipality for the area. Coun McNair also attended an LSD meeting in Rockland. Both meetings were very positive. Good interest was shown to join a regional municipality. The next phase is to have council make a motion to proceed with the study by the province. On Motion to proceed with the feasibility study by the province for the village to join a regional municipality. The River Run was a great success again this year.
