Department and Committee Reports:

There is room on the property to build about 35 units next to hospital. Also, Mr. Rankine would like to build an apartment complex for staff. Mr. Rankine has also purchased some properties in the village. Councillor McNair reported that he would like to see some street redevelopment along Main Street from Martins Crossing to the bank. It would be nice to access the river.

Community Development: Councillor McIntosh reported that the trail has a lot of spots where grass is growing on the trail. Councillor McIntosh would like to see this addressed as a lot of people use the trail. Too late in the season but will look at addressing this come spring. Councillor McIntosh will be meeting with Ms. O'Donnell to decorate for fall.
